During his career, he combined a solid professional expertise as consultant (for institutions such as the World Bank, the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development or OECD), with high-rank positions at the executive and legislative levels, as President of the National Agency for Privatization and member of the first freely elected Parliament (Constitutive Meeting) of Romania, between 1990 and 1992.

Until May 2007, he was the General Manager of the subsidiary BRD Corporate Finance and the coordinator of the investment banking activities developed by BRD.

He held the positions of Member of the Board of Directors of some companies' members of BRD Group, SIF Muntenia, State Ownership Fund, and Romanian Centre for Economic Policies (CEROPE) - a non-governmental centre for studies.

Before 1990, he had an academic career, as researcher with the National Economy Institute of the Romanian Academy. He gave speeches at conferences, seminars, etc.; published more than 80 articles and studies.

Now he is Managing partner, S.C. CONCEPT – Economic and Business Consulting S.R.L. , an investment banking and general consulting boutique and Member of the Board of Directors of BRD Finance IFN S.A.
